**1. Where are you from? Who introduced you to HBCUs?\***

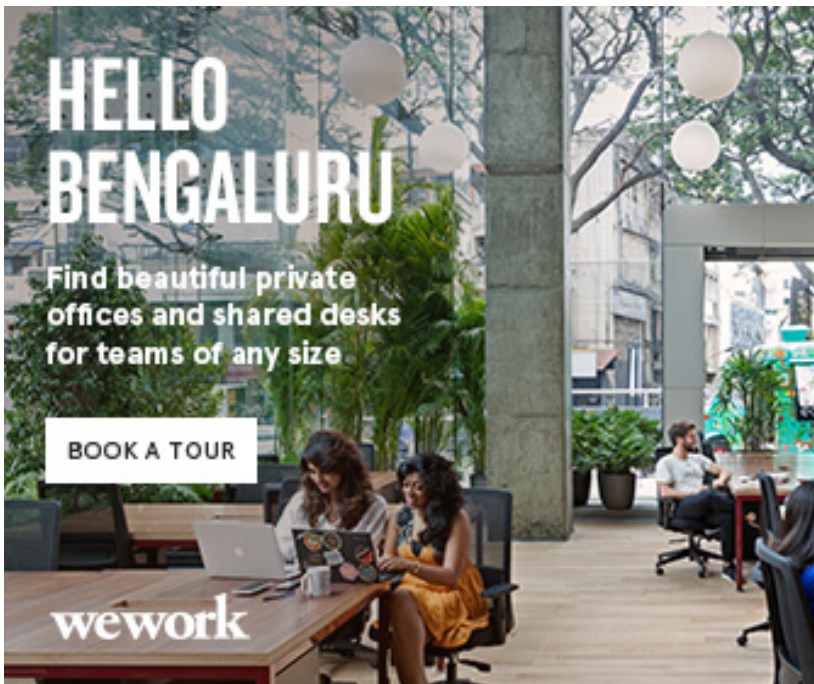
I'm from the great city of Atlanta, GA. I was probably hearing about HBCUs in the womb. We have more HBCU graduates than PWI graduates in my family.
