1. Where are you from? Who introduced you to HBCUs?*

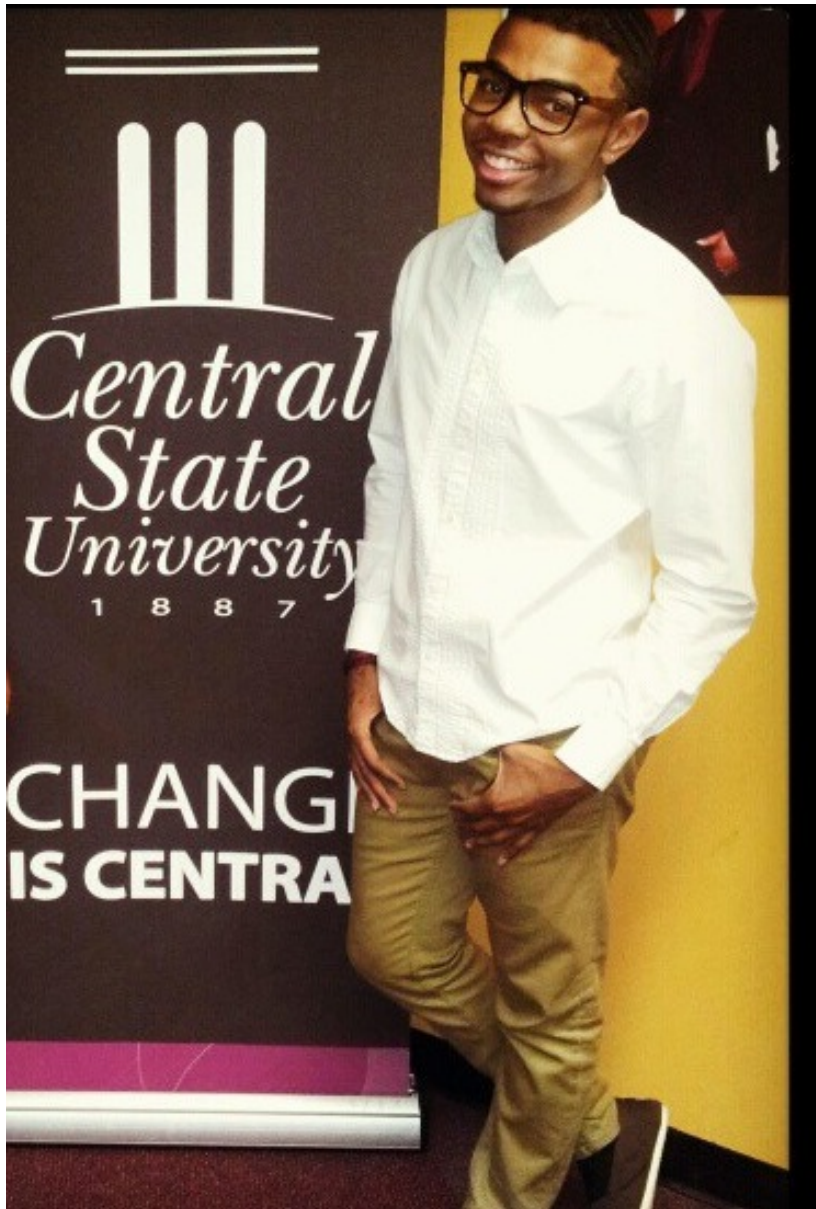
